Asian Poison Ivy	<i>Toxicodendron orientale</i>	East Asia
Brazilian Pepper Plant	<i>Schinus terebinthifolius</i>	Australia, Caribbean, India, Pacific Islands, Southern US, South America
Cashew Nut Tree	<i>Anacardium occidentale</i>	Worldwide
Chinese Varnish Tree	<i>Toxicodendron potaninii</i>	China
Lacquer Tree	<i>Toxicodendron vernicifluum</i>	China, Japan, Korea
Mango Plant	<i>Mangifera indica</i>	Worldwide in frost free climates including California, Florida, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico
Manzanilla	<i>Toxicodendron striatum</i>	South America
Pistachio Tree	<i>Pistacia vera</i>	Afghanistan (<i>especially the provinces of Samangan and Badghis</i>), Egypt, Greece, India, Iran, Iraq, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Pakistan, Sicily, Syria, Tajikistan, Tunisia, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan,
Poisonwood Plant	<i>Metopium toxiferum</i>	Southern Florida, Caribbean, Central & South America
Small Flowered Poison Sumac	<i>Toxicodendron parviflorum</i>	Bhutan, India
African Poison Ivy	<i>Smodingium argutum</i>	South Africa
Wax Tree	<i>Toxicodendron succedaneum</i>	Australia, China, India, Nepal, New Zealand
